INTRODUCING MUSIC AS A PART OF LIFE.

In this program children will:

- Explore the basic elements of music. Using poetry, books with songs the students will learn to feel a steady beat.
- Students will learn what melody is about by singing songs in their tradition.
- Have fun. Learning to sing and match pitch as group musical games are performed.
- Explore the use of rhythm instruments. Coordination with eye, and both left and right hand playing a rhythm instrument prepares the students to play a musical instrument.
- Stretch their attention span through the use of many different musical activities such as clapping and playing instruments while learning to read rhythms.
- Developing imagination through musical listening of the great master composers

At the end of this course we want our young students to:

- Participate in a musical group.
- Sing childhood songs on key.
- Demonstrate tempo through the use of Presto and Largo.
- Demonstrate dynamics through the use of Forte and Piano
- Identify by clapping and playing rhythms with rhythm instruments.
- Learn simple notation and listen to music of the great composers.
- Perform for their family and friends.
